2. JOB SUMMARY:

This position is responsible for carrying out market and financial services assessment, facilitating market and financial linkages and building capacity of graduating GENCAD businesses for integration in the relevant financial and market system. He/she to liaise with relevant government structures and engage with market actors (product and financials) to ensure GENCAD entrepreneurs take advantage of emerging opportunities that foster growth of their businesses.

3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

3.1 Market Facilitation and Linkages:

- 3.1.1 Develop linkages strategy for commodity markets, supporting services and government structures within the County.
- 3.1.2 Profile businesses and savings groups (by business) for linkages and integration within specific product's value chains and the larger markets system.
- 3.1.3 Build capacity of selected savings groups for linkages with buyers and integration in the market through delivering of customized business development services (BDS).



- 3.1.4 Foster linkages of GENCAD businesses and saving groups (SGs) to markets including financial service providers and other government opportunities.
- 3.1.5 Support market-oriented projects interventions and strengthen linkages for GENCAD Kuza Jamii graduated groups with government department and other relevant institutions.

3.2 Livelihood Research and Learning:

- 3.2.1 Research and evaluate alternative livelihood opportunities to improve and adapt local self-reliance strategies in GENCAD's areas of operations.
- 3.2.2 Conduct livelihoods assessments including market analysis, socio-economic assessments, institutional mappings, and infrastructure surveys that inform market linkages design and interventions in various regions/locations.
- 3.2.3 Support in implementation of appropriate business monitoring systems and development of the program report.
- 3.2.4 Provide capacity development, training and dissemination of market linkages to the team.

- 3.5.4 Maintain good public relations and promote visibility on the work of GENCAD.

- 3.2.7 Possesses self-drive, has good interpersonal, public relations and team orientation skills with ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds and at the local community level.
